Trinity Crafts at the Hiscock House Provincial Historic Site has been run for over thirty (30) years by a local organization, first by the Trinity Craft Co-Op and then by the Bonaventure English Harbour Development Association, both under the store name of Trinity Crafts.

Trinity Crafts offers an outlet for local crafters to sell and promote their work. All work is reviewed by a quality control committee and the store manager. Product is taken on consignment basis. These consignment goods are supplemented with items that we purchase that are not readily available locally.

We offer quality, local hand made products ie: knitwear, crochet work, quilts, art, woodwork, jewellery and homemade jams and jellies. To round out the product line we sell postcards, books and music. Presently we have over fifty people who bring their products to us and that results in a significant benefit to the economy of the local area.

The shop operates daily from mid May to mid October.
